Pastor's Ponderings -

Do you ever wonder what God is thinking? I think we all do once in a while. We wonder what He's thinking when something awful happens in the world. We wonder what He thinks of us. When something bad happens in our life we wonder if God made that happen because He's mad at us, or is He punishing us, or is He getting back at us for some reason. That's the way people operate, but not God. He really doesn't need to 'get back at us'. He does many times want to teach us something, and that can be through discipline and correction. And to be sure punishment will come if we refuse to repent as He calls us to repent and follow Him in obedience. But the flat tire on the way to work, or the morning coffee spilled on the laptop is probably not God's way of 'getting back at you' for your lack of whatever it is that you think God is mad at you for. Many times we can get caught up in this mindset that 'God is really mad at me', and with His heavy-handed fist, or hammer as some tend to think, He's always looking for ways to bring it down on our head in order to smash us like a bug. Now let's be clear, the Bible says very plainly, "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, declares the Lord...as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts higher than your thoughts." Isaiah 55:8-9 But God is not all about coming down on you with His bug thumb in order to squash you flat.

We understand that we cannot know the mind of God. We aren't going to know what God is thinking. But we can know enough about the heart and the mind of God to know He loves us and has a wonderful plan for our lives. Isaiah 55:7 tells us to "turn to the Lord because He will have mercy on us, and to turn to our God because He will freely pardon." Isaiah 55:6 instructs us to "seek the Lord while He may be found and to call upon Him while He is near." Why are we invited to do this? Because God promises that when we do, He will freely pardon us and have mercy on us. Does that not give us some very clear vision into what God is thinking? Isaiah 55:1 is very clear, it says, "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat. Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost." God's heart is one of invitation and tremendous giving, especially to those who cannot afford it. God thinks of you in terms of love, grace and mercy. In other words, God loves to pardon sinners and set them free.

As we prepare for Easter this year, so many people need to know that God is thinking about them. Is there someone that needs to be introduced to the inviting heart of God? Be praying for them. They need to know how much God loves them, and that He sent His son to die on the cross to save them and set them free. They need to have the opportunity to hear the Gospel and be introduced to the One who loves them with such full extension of grace and love and mercy that His Son stretched out His arms on the Cross of Calvary, shedding His precious blood for all. In so doing Jesus said, "I love you this much."

Together in this ministry with you...of calling people to Christ, that they might see the heart of One who loves them. We invite them to come to Him and receive freely and fully.




